ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

Applications for admission are accepted in April/May. After the admission form has been duly filled and the advance tuition fee for the first month and admission fees are paid, the formal admission procedure will be carried forward. Medical certificates with fitness and vaccinations by a registered medical practitioner should be provided during the time of submission of admission form. An amount of Rs 500/- must be paid by each student for the admission form and prospectus when applying for admission to the school. Applications for admission and all correspondence should be sent in the school address (Given in the website). The school management expects the parents/ guardians to help and encourage their wards at home to reach the proper standard of education besides the teaching in the school. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any student without giving any reasons. Enrolment in the school implies, on the part of the student and parent's willingness to comply with the requirements and regulations of the school. Parents are earnestly requested to co-operate with the work of the school by enforcing discipline and regularities and by tasking a general interest in the child's progress. No student suffering from any infectious/ contagious disease can be admitted into the school. There are limited seats in the school for every class, so "FIRST COME-FIRST SERVE".

During the time of the formal admission procedure of the child, Text books, exercise books and Uniform will be provided in the school.

The parents are requested to strictly follow the calendar of holidays allotted to them by the school authorities. In the event of withdrawal of the student from the school, all dues must be cleared in full before a transfer certificate is issued. The school management acting through the Principal will require the withdrawal of a student who fails two consecutive years in the same class. A student remaining absent for a week consecutively without any intimation to the school authorities, will be struck off from the admission roll.

CURRICULUM AND EXAMINATION

Moral and ethical instruction for a compulsory part of the curriculum and numerous activities are encouraged which make up for the physical and culture development of the students. A pupil who fails to attain the required standard in all subjects will not be promoted. The Annual Examination is meant to confirm the result of the whole years work. Promotions are granted on the basis of the whole years work. The decision of the school authorities with regard to promotion is final. Parents are earnestly requested to co-operate with the work of the school by enforcing regularity and discipline and by taking a general interest in the children's progress. The school aims at building a strong foundation for bringing out the pupils inner inborn talents through the activities of the school. It aims at building character, discipline, honesty, loyalty, obedience, courtesy, responsibility, generosity and diligence among the students. The medium used will only be English. This will ensure and encourage the students to learn English in an easy way. As education is necessary for all walks of life and for all ages.

PINE DALE PUBLIC SCHOOL aims at developing the child to perfection. There will be two examinations at the end of the two terms i.e, first term/ half yearly in October, second term / final term in March. The school will follow the CBSE / CCE course only. Besides instructional classes students will be taught physical education like PT and sports. Culture activities and crafts, paper work, origami etc. to reach and fulfill the all round development of the child. Weekly tests will be conducted regularly and the answer scripts are to be endorsed by the parents only 10% of the weekly tests results will be added to the total final term. At the end of the full term an annual function will be held where parents / guardians are invited and there will be distribution of prizes for successful candidates.

GENERAL

The parents are requested to keep strictly to the calendar of holidays allowed by the school authorities. In the event of withdrawal of the student from the school all dues must be cleared in full before a transfer certificate can be issued. EXAMINATION

The assessment for the final term is 10 % of the weekly test + 90% of final term = 100%. It is compulsory to sit for all the tests and exams.

CELEBRATION

The school celebrates Local, State and National holidays .The School Annual Day / Parent's Day is celebrated at the end of the academics session. Students are awarded for best academic performance, discipline, cleanliness attendance and best child of the year.

EDUCOMP SMART CLASS

It is the latest technology introduced in the school to empower teaching and inspire learning, it is to equip the children and the school to lead a digital revolution and initiative to bring abstract and difficult curriculum concepts to life, makes learning an enjoyable experience in students enables with-sensory learning in classrooms, improves academic performance of students, and improves teachers effectiveness and productivity. SCHOOL UNIFORM

School uniform is available in the school at a reasonable rate for both boys and girls, except for black shoes, white canvas PT shoe, white sock and a red polo neck.

FEES

DOCUMENTS

The following documents are to be submitted along with the admission form at the time of admission :

- a) Birth certificate (Nursery – min 3 +yrs and above, LKG – min 4 yrs and above)
- b) Transfer Certificate (for students above Class I only)
- c) Medical fitness certificate (Polio, BCG,BTP and blood groups of your ward is compulsory)
- d) Two – passport size and two stamp size photographs)
- e) Progress card/ Report card from the previous school.

REJECTION OF STUDENTS

The Principal has the right to reject the admission of a child without any reason.

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

At the time of admission the presence of any one parent is compulsory. Admission will be given on first come first serve basis as the seats are limited.

SPECIAL FEATURES

- a) School offers computer education from LKG upwards.
- b) Exemption of monthly tuition fee only of the child of a staff employed in the school.
- c) Special Tuition classes are provided by the teaching staff of the school for all classes.

For better and smooth functioning of the school, only ideal suggestions from parents are always welcome.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

- 1) School runs from 9 : 00 am to 1 : 30 p.m. from Monday to Saturday (Nursery)
- 2) School runs from 9 : 00 am to 1 : 30 p.m. from Monday Friday(LKG & UKG)
- 3) School runs from 9 : 00 am to 3 : 00 p.m. from Monday Friday(Class I to Class X)
- 4) School runs from 9 : 00 am to 1 : 00 p.m. on Saturday (For all)
- 5) Teacher and students should report at school at least fifteen (15) minutes before assembly.
- 6) If a student remains absent during normal days without any written application a fine of Rs 50/- will be charged per day and a fine of Rs 100/- will be charged during the examination period including the weekly Saturday test days.
- 7) School remains closed on Second Saturday and National and Local holidays.
- 8) Any student who reaches school, after the re-opening of the school and hostel will be fined Rs 200/- only per head. It is compulsory for all students to be present in school and hostel on the first day after any vacation.
- 9) If a student remains absent during normal days without any written application, a fine of Rs 50/- will be charged per day and a fine of Rs 100/- will be charged during the examination period including the weekly Saturday test days.
- 10) The school remains closed on Second Saturday ,National and Local holidays.
- 11) Any student who reaches the school, after the re-opening of the school will be fined Rs 200/- per head. It is compulsory for all students to be present in the school on the first day after any vacation.
- 12) Each student should carry its identity card and school diary.
- 13) Students who come to school escorted will not leave the school without an escort or a guardian.

- 14) Students once enter the school campus will not be permitted to leave under any circumstances other than the Principal's permission.
- 15) Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school, if found so it will be confiscated and not returned.
- 16) Students are not allowed to wear jewellery to school or any other accessories besides small earrings only.
- 17) Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The complete uniform should be worn on all working days and a Saturday uniform only for Saturdays.
- 18) All boys to keep their hair short and all girls must tie/ braid their hair neatly with a red band.
- 19) Students using school bus will maintain discipline in the bus.
- 20) Students are advised to keep their classrooms, school buildings and campus clean as possible. And throw leftovers in the dustbins in order to maintain a clean and green environment.
- 21) Students should not join other students in violent and destructive activities or they will be subjected to rustication or expulsion.
- 22) Students using unfair means during exams will face disciplinary action as decided by the school authorities.
- 23) The class teacher of every class will maintain the percentage of attendance of more than 75% for each and every student which will be calculated at the end of the semester.
- 24) Lending and borrowing of books, papers, magazines and articles (other than the school text books and library books) is not allowed.
- 25) Students are expected to respect the school property. No student should damage the school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others. Any school property damaged even unknowingly should be reported to the class teacher or to the chairman or Principal.
- 26) Parent's must provide complete medical history of the child prior to admission, lack of which the school authorities should not be held responsible.
- 27) No students shall indulge in any of the following practices, namely:
 - a. Any form of gambling.
 - b. Smoking, Chewing of tobacco etc.
 - c. Spitting in and near the school property.
 - d. Use of drugs or intoxicants, except on prescription by a registered medical practitioner.
 - e. Rowdyism and rude behavior.
 - f. Use of violence in any form.
 - g. Casteism, Communalism and Untouchability in any form.
 - h. Bringing electronic devices such as mobile phones, mp3 players, cameras etc to school without the permission of the class teachers will be confiscated if found so and will not be returned.
